God is wondrous in His saints. In the churches, bless ye God.

The Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Hebrews. (11:33-12:2).

Brethren, all the saints through faith subdued kingdoms, worked righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, quenched the power of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, from weakness were made strong, became mighty in war, and turned to flight armies of the aliens. Women received their dead by resurrection, and others were tortured, not accepting their deliverance, that they might obtain a better resurrection. And others suffered mocking and scourging, and even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, they were tempted, they were slain with the sword; they went about in skins of sheep and goats, being destitute, afflicted, tormented (of whom the world was not worthy), wandering in deserts and mountains, and in dens and caves of the earth. And all these, having obtained a witness through their faith, did not receive the promise, since God had foreseen something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect. Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which does so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the Author and Perfecter of our faith.

THE SYNAXARION

On June 27, in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate of our righteous father Sampson the host of strangers; and Mary and Joanna the myrrh-bearers. On this day, the Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the feast of All Saints who shone forth throughout all the world, North and South, East and West.

David the Prophet and king, who revered the beloved of God, and respected them because of his great piety, said in the Psalms, "How precious are Thy beloved unto me, O God" (138:17). And the Apostle Paul, in his Epistle to the Hebrews,


recounted the lives of the saints, when he wrote, "Wherefore, seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin that so easily besets us; and let us run with patience the race that is set before us" (12:1). Therefore, as Orthodox Christians, we honor the beloved saints of God, respecting them as keepers of God's commandments, shining examples of virtue and benefactors of humanity. We commemorate all of the holy ones every year on this day, as the list of saints ever increases, even though some of their names escape us. Nevertheless, we honor them for their piety and strive to imitate their good works.

By the intercessions of Thine immaculate Mother, O Christ God, and of all Thy Saints from the beginning of time, have mercy and save us, since Thou alone art good and the Lover of mankind. Amen.





Essay #3: Written by Tony Barjoud

Last week, we published an essay from one of the participants in the Archpriest Michael Husson Award (by Christian Mounayyer). To continue honoring the participants, we are featuring the rest of the essays submitted. This week's essay was written by Tony Barjoud. PLEASE NOTE that they were being featured in random order.

“Ever since the start of the Covid-19 outbreak, I've had to stay home almost every single day even when I had school. For the last year I was forced to take all my classes virtually. Taking these classes online made me concentrate less during the lectures of my teachers because I had to sit down staring at a screen for a long time without taking any breaks, which caused me to get tired and bored. Because of COVID, I was unable to see my teachers in person to ask for help on any of my assignments, which made me take more time to complete an assignment. Since the assignments took longer to complete, I had less time to study for each of my exams.

During the lockdown I wasn't allowed to go to many places or see any of my friends. When I did go places, I wore a mask and stayed six feet away from everyone. Because of the pandemic I would be scared to get the virus and spread it to family whenever I left my house. Being forced to stay home all day has been a challenge because all I can do is play games and exercise by myself. It gets very stressful when I'm bored of everything and am unable to hang out with my friend.

Knowing how easily covid spreads I had to worry that my parents might get the virus at their jobs. I was scared that they would get really sick and spread the virus to more people. They had a high chance of getting it because their jobs involve being close to other people and this is one of the main ways to catch the disease. Luckily, they have never gotten the virus even when being highly exposed to it.

Ever since this virus started, I haven't been able to go to church because I didn't want to risk getting covid. I had to miss many church events and the services on Sundays because of this pandemic. I wasn't even able to watch the service because of how many assignments I had to do for my school and all the things I had to do for my college. Because of covid I wasn't able to see my friends from church and learn new things from Sunday school, which is upsetting because I really enjoy learning new things in Sunday school.

My relationship with God has improved even with everything that's going on. Because I'm home all day I have more time to pray. Especially with all the scary things that are happening now, He makes me feel safe and not needing to feel like I'm in danger. God has protected me and my family from the virus. And after all my prayers, a vaccine has been finally created and is being distributed to everyone who is over the age of twelve. My whole family and I were lucky enough to get both vaccine doses. Since we got both doses we are basically fully protected from getting the virus and we are able to live a normal life, not being scared of getting sick.”
