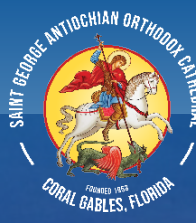

Apolytikion of the Resurrection (Tone Five)

Let us believers praise and worship the Word; coeternal with the Father and the Spirit, born of the Virgin for our salvation. For, He took pleasure in ascending the Cross in the flesh to suffer death; and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection..

My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart shall be of understanding.

Hear this, all ye people.

The Reading from the Epistle of St. Paul to the Hebrew (7:26-8:2)

Brethren, it was fitting that we should have such a High Priest, holy, blameless, unstained, separated from sinners, exalted above the heavens. He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for his own sins and then for those of the people; He did this once for all when He offered up Himself. Indeed, the law appoints men in their weakness as high priests, but the word of the oath, which came later than the law, appoints a Son Who has been made perfect forever. Now the point in what we are saying is this: we have such a High Priest, one Who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, a minister in the sanctuary and the true tent which is set up not by man but by the Lord.

The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Luke (10:25-37)

At that time, a lawyer stood up to put Jesus to the test, saying, "Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus said to him, "What is written in the Law? How do you read?" And the lawyer answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself." And Jesus said to him, "You have answered right; do this, and you will live." But the lawyer, desiring to justify himself, said to Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus replied, "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and he fell among robbers, who stripped him and beat him, and departed, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a priest was going down that road; and when he saw him he passed by on the other side. So likewise a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan, as he journeyed, came to where he was; and when he saw him, he had compassion, and went to him and bound up his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; then he set him on his own beast and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. And the next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper, saying, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, I will repay you when I come back.' Which of these three, do you think, proved neighbor to the man who fell among the robbers?" The lawyer said, "The one who showed mercy on him." And Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."

في ذلك الزمان، دنا إلى يسوع ناموسي وقال، مُجرباً له: يا معلّم، ماذا أعمل لأرث الحياة الأبدية. فقال له: ماذا كُتِبَ في التّاموس؟ كيف تقرأ؟ فأجاب وقال: أحبّ الربّ إلهك من كلّ قلبك، ومن كلّ نفسك، ومن كلّ قدرتك، ومن كلّ ذهنك، وقريبك كنفسك. فقال له: بالصواب أجبت. إعمل ذلك فتخيا. فأراد أن يزيّي نفسه فقال لیسوع: ومن قريبي؟ فعاد يسوع وقال: كان إنساناً مُنحدرًا من أورشليم إلى أريحا، فوقع بين لُصوص. فعروه وجرحوه وتركوه بين حيّ وميت. فانفق أن كاهناً كان مُنحدرًا في ذلك الطريق، فأبصره وجاز من أمامه. وكذلك لاوي، وأتى إلى المكان، فأبصره وجاز من أمامه. ثم إن سامرياً مسافراً مرّ به، فلما رآه تحنّن. فدنا إليه وضمّد جراحاته، وصبّ عليها زيتاً وخمراً، وحملّه على دابته، وأتى به إلى فندق، واعتنى بأمّره. وفي الغد، فيما هو خارج، أخرج دينارين وأعطاهما لصاحب الفندق وقال له: اعتن بأمّره، ومهما تنفق فوق هذا فأنا أدفعه لك عند عودتي. فأى هؤلاء الثلاثة تحسب صار قريباً للذي وقع بين اللّصوص؟ قال: الذي صنع إليه الرحمة. فقال له يسوع: امض فاصنع أنت أيضاً كذلك.

THE SYNAXARION



On November 13 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate **Saint John Chrysostom**.

Our father among the saints John Chrysostom (347-407), Archbishop of Constantinople, was a notable Christian bishop and preacher from the fourth and fifth centuries in Syria and Constantinople. He is famous for his eloquence in public speaking, his philanthropy, his denunciation of abuse of authority in the Church and in the Roman Empire of the time, and for a Divine Liturgy attributed to him. He had notable ascetic sensibilities. After his death he was named Chrysostom, which comes from the Greek, "golden-mouthed."

The Orthodox Church honors him as a saint (feast day, November 13) and counts him among the Three Holy Hierarchs (feast day, January 30), together with Saints Basil the Great and Gregory the Theologian. Another feast day associated with him is January 27, which commemorates the event in 437, thirty years after the saint's repose, when his relics were brought back to Constantinople from the place of his death.

John Chrysostom is also recognized by the Roman Catholic Church, which considers him a saint and Doctor of the Church, and by the Church of England, both of whom commemorate him on September 13. His relics were stolen from Constantinople by crusaders in 1204 and brought to Rome, but were returned on November 27, 2004, by Pope John Paul II.

He is sometimes referred to as "John of Antioch," but that name more properly refers to the bishop of Antioch in A.D. 429-441, who led a group of moderate Eastern bishops in the Nestorian controversy.

The Mystery of Repentance: Every Christian feels a natural yearning of the heart towards God, a true desire to taste the sweetness of communion with Him as He created us to be. This longing for inner peace can be fulfilled as we participate in the spiritual life within the Orthodox Church. In particular, the Mystery of Repentance (Holy Confession) restores us to a blessed union with the Living God.

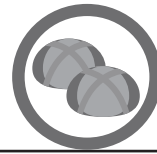

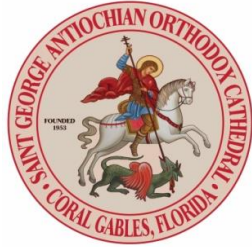
