#### The Reading from the Second Epistle of St. Paul to St. Corinthians. (6:12-20)

Brethren, all things are lawful for me, but not all things are expedient. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the authority of anything. Foods are for the belly, and the belly for foods; but God will destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body; and God both raised up the Lord, and will also raise us up through His power. Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I therefore take away the members of Christ, and make them members of a harlot? God forbid! Or, do you not know that he who is joined to a harlot is one body with her? For, "The two," He says, "shall become one flesh." But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit. Flee fornication! Every sin that a person commits is outside the body, but whoever commits fornication sins against his own body. Or, do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have received from God, and that you are not your own? 


#### The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Luke (15:11-32)

The Lord spoke this parable: "There was a man who had two sons; and the younger of them said to his father, 'Father, give me the share of property that falls to me.' And he divided his living between them. Not many days later, the younger son gathered all he had and took his journey into a far country, and there he squandered his property in loose living. And when he had spent everything, a great famine arose in that country, and he began to be in want. So he went and joined himself to one of the citizens of that country, who sent him into his fields to feed swine. And he would gladly have fed on the pods that the swine ate; and no one gave him anything. But when he came to himself he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, but I perish here with hunger! I will arise and go to my father, and I will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son; treat me as one of your hired servants." And he arose and came to his father. But while he was yet at a distance, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and embraced him and kissed him. And the son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son.' But the father said to his servants, 'Bring quickly the best robe, and put it on him; and put a ring on his hand, and shoes on his feet; and bring the fatted calf and kill it, and let us eat and make merry; for this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found.' And they began to make merry. Now his elder son was in the field; and as he came and drew near to the house, he heard music and dancing. And he called one of the servants and asked what this meant. And he said to him, 'Your brother has come, and your father has killed the fatted calf, because he has received him safe and sound.' But he was angry and refused to go in. His father came out and entreated him, but he answered his father, 'Lo, these many years I have served you, and I never disobeyed your command; yet you never gave me a kid that I might make merry with my friends. But when this son of yours came, who has devoured your living with harlots, you killed for him the fatted calf!' And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours. It was fitting to make merry and be glad, for this your brother was dead, and is alive; he was lost, and is found.""

#### THE SYNAXARION

On February 12 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate **the Prodigal Son.** 

On the third Sunday of preparation for Lent, we hear the parable of the Prodigal Son (LK. 15:11-32). Together with the hymns on this day, the parable reveals to us the time of repentance as man's return from exile. The prodigal son, we are told, went to a far country and there spent all that he had. A far country! It is this unique definition of our human condition that we must assume and make ours as we begin our approach to God. A man who has never had that experience, be it only very briefly, who has never felt that he is exiled from God and from real life, will never understand what Christianity is about.

And the one who is perfectly "at home" in this world and its life, who has never been wounded by the nostalgic desire for another Reality, will not understand what is

repentance.

Repentance is often simply identified as a cool and "objective" enumeration of sins and transgressions, as the act of "pleading guilty" to a legal indictment. Confession and absolution are seen as being of a juridical nature. But something very essential is overlooked-- without which neither confession nor absolution have any real meaning or power. This "something" is precisely the feeling of alienation from God, from the joy of communion with Him, from the real life as created and given by God. It is easy indeed to confess that I have not fasted on prescribed days, or missed my prayers, or become angry. It is quite a different thing, however, to realize suddenly that I have defiled and lost my spiritual beauty, that I am far away from my real home, my real life, and that something precious and pure and beautiful has been hopelessly broken in the very texture of my existence. Yet this, and only this, is repentance, and therefore it is also a deep desire to return, to go back, to recover that lost home....

One liturgical peculiarity of this "Sunday of the Prodigal Son" must be especially mentioned here. At Sunday Matins, following the solemn and joyful Psalms of the

Polyeleion, we sing the sad and nostalgic Psalm 137:

By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, and we wept when we remembered Zion... How shall we sing the Lord's song in a strange land? If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget her cunning. If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy...

It is the Psalm of exile. It was sung by the Jews in their Babylonian captivity as they thought of their holy city of Jerusalem. It has become forever the song of man as he realizes his exile form God, and realizing it, becomes man again: the one who can never be fully satisfied by anything in this fallen world, for by nature and vocation he is a pilgrim of the Absolute. This Psalm will be sung twice more: on the last two Sundays before Lent. It reveals Lent itself as pilgrimage and repentance-- as return.

Beloved Brother Hierarchs, reverend Clergy, and Christ-loving Faithful,

Greetings to you in the Name of our Lord, God, and Savior Jesus Christ.

This week we learned with heavy hearts of the devastation wrought by the powerful earthquake in Turkey and Syria. The toll of death and destruction is only slowly coming to light, but it is clear that thousands have died and the lives and livelihoods of many have been wrecked. In these moments, as our hearts break for our fellow man—especially for our brothers and sisters in the Faith—we feel acutely what St. Paul said about the Body of Christ: "When one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it" (1 Cor. 12:26).

Brethren, the same apostle teaches us to share what we have with those who are now in need, knowing that a time may come when they can help us. He writes, "It is not that you should be burdened so that others might have it easy. Rather, out of equality, your abundance should now go toward their need, so that their abundance might someday supply your need, so that there might be equality" (2 Cor. 8:13–14). This openhearted sharing is an affirmation of our bonds with those now suffering. It is also an expression of love, which always takes the burden of the beloved upon one's own shoulders.

I call upon all our parishes to collect contributions each Sunday throughout the month of February for the relief of those suffering as a result of this earthquake. Immediately after each Sunday, each parish should mail a check for the funds collected that Sunday to our archdiocese headquarters and email the total amount to Mr. Daniel Nehme at our headquarters (dnehme@antiochian.org), which will allow us to distribute the funds more quickly. Individuals can also contribute online at antiochian.org/earthquake. We will forward the collected funds to His Beatitude Patriarch John X as they come in, as a demonstration of our love, to be distributed through our patriarchal relief agencies to those affected by this disaster.

#### Beloved in Christ.

This year, our journey through the Lenten fast to Pascha begins at Forgiveness Sunday, February 26. The Church, in her wisdom, begins preparing us for this most-holy time in the weeks that precede the fast. This email provides encouragement for you regarding the fasting guidelines for the pre-Lenten period of preparation, Great Lent, and Holy Week, according to the general practice in our Diocese.

The word "fast" means not eating all or certain foods. Simultaneously, we should be fasting from sin while praying more and living more fully the Orthodox life. Fast is a personal, spiritual discipline. We aren't to compare our fasting with anyone else. Neither should we be prideful about our fasting nor judge those who don't fully participate in this spiritual journey.

Saint John Chrysostom teaches that it is more important to fast from sin. For example, besides controlling what goes into our mouths, we must control what comes out of our mouths as well. He notes that other members of the body also need to fast: (1) our eyes from seeing evil, (2) our ears from hearing evil and (3) our bodies from participating in anything that is not of God. Most important of all, we need to control our thoughts, for thoughts are the sources of our actions, whether good or evil.

Fasting isn't forced upon us. In the same way that true repentance can never be forced upon anyone, each of us makes the choice to turn away from our sinful ways and go toward our loving, forgiving Father in heaven.

We shouldn't give up if we fail in some aspect of our fasting. Remember, we are beginners in one way or another on this spiritual journey of becoming like Christ. If we fail, no matter in a small or big way, we should resume fasting and other spiritual activities. Remember, the evil demons want us to give up! It is important to note that fasting is a spiritual discipline that should be practiced with the oversight and direction of your spiritual father.

#### Why do we fast?

- > To become like Jesus Who also fasted.
- > To be assisted in our repentance and our movement towards God, (St. Basil the Great),
- > To speak a little less, so as to hear the whisper of God's voice more,
- > To cleanse our lives from sin,
- > To grow closer to the Lord,
- > To gain control of our appetites of the flesh and let God transform our lives, and most importantly,
- > To deepen our relationship with Christ, which will result having more love toward God and our neighbor.

#### WEEKS OF PREPARATION 2023 (February 5 – 26)

Four Sundays of preparation precede Great Lent. The Church eases us into the fasting discipline during these weeks of preparation as follows:

• February 5 was the Sunday of the **Publican and Pharisee** and the <u>week that follows (February 6 – 12)</u> is fast-free. There is no Wednesday or Friday fast this week.

- February 12 is the Sunday of the Prodigal Son and the week that follows (February 13 19) is a
  normal week with Wednesday and Friday as fasting days.
- February 19 is Meatfare Sunday (the Sunday of the Last Judgment) and on this day we say "farewell" to meat. <u>During the week that follows (February 20 26) we fast from meat only</u>. <u>All dairy, cheese, eggs, wine, and oil are permitted during this week, even on Wednesday and Friday</u>.
- February 26 is **Cheesefare Sunday** (the Sunday of Forgiveness) and on this day we say "farewell" to cheese, dairy, eggs, wine and olive oil while continuing to abstain from meat and fish.

#### **GREAT LENT AND HOLY WEEK 2023 (February 27 – April 15)**

The Lenten fasting discipline commences after Forgiveness Vespers on March 6 and concludes with the breaking of the fast at Pascha on April 16. In general, the fasting rules during Great Lent and Holy Week are as follows:

**WEEKDAYS** (Monday – Friday) are observed as *Strict Fast Days*. On these days we abstain from meat, dairy, fish with backbones, fowl, wine and oil.

**WEEKENDS** (Saturday and Sunday) are observed as *Wine and Oil Days*. On these days the fast is relaxed to permit wine and olive oil.

In addition, two special feastdays that fall during this period – *Annunciation* (March 25) and *Palm Sunday* (April 9, this year) – are kept as *Fish*, *Wine*, *and Oil Days*. On these days the fast is relaxed to permit fish with backbones, in addition to wine and olive oil.

There are certain days of the Holy Week cycle that have special fasting rules.

- Great and Holy Thursday (April 13, this year) is observed as a Wine and Oil Day due to the commemoration of the institution of the Eucharist.
- Great and Holy Saturday (April 15, this year) is observed as a Strict Fast Day the only Saturday of the year kept as a strict fast; however, wine (but not oil) is permitted.

#### Additional Notes:

- 1. Meals portions should be smaller than usual.
- 2. Fasting on the weekdays of the first week of Great Lent is especially severe. The strictest observance would be to take only 2 meals during this week 1 on Wednesday evening and 1 on Friday evening after the services scheduled for those nights keeping Clean Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday as absolute fasts (i.e., no food whatsoever). For many this is impracticable. A good starting place to work towards the strict observance is to keep the first day of Great Lent, Clean Monday, as an absolute fast and to limit meals on the other days.
- 3. It is a pious practice to observe Great and Holy Friday as an absolute fast. If one does not have the strength to do this, it is good to abstain from food until after venerating the epitaphios (winding sheet) during Vespers on this day.
- 4. If you have a medical condition that requires you to relax the fasting guidelines, then do so.
- 5. Generally speaking, beginners plus children and elderly people are allowed to relax the fast under the guidance of their spiritual father.

Please consult me before you attempt to strictly follow the fasting guidelines. Fasting is an ideal for which we should strive, but it is not end in itself. Becoming like Jesus is our ultimate goal.

#### **Home Blessing Scheduling Form**

On January 6th, we celebrated the services for the Great Feast of Theophany (عيد الغطاس), in which we commemorate the Baptism of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We also prayed the service of the "Great Sanctification of Water", which marks the beginning of the home blessing season. Traditionally, the blessed waters are used to sanctify the homes of all the faithful. In bringing the blessed water to the homes, and sprinkling it in each room, we rid our home of any evil influence, and re-dedicate it to God in a special way. As we were once renewed by the waters of our own baptism into Christ, so too our home, and our entire lives, are re-dedicated and renewed unto Christ our God each year at this time.

- The home blessing form MUST be filled out and submitted either online or using this form.
   Please return to Fr. Paul or the Church office.
- A follow-up call will take place from the Church Office to confirm the appointment day and time.
- 3. Fr. Paul will contact you before arriving to your home (at least 15 minutes prior to arrival). He will call you once more when he is in front of the house.

The official Clergy Manual of the Antiochian Archdiocese of North America states: The pastor MUST SEE that the home of EACH PARISHIONER is visited and blessed each year during the days following Epiphany or other Major Feast Days where the weather conditions are permissible. Therefore, please, let nothing stand in between the priest and the fulfillment of his priestly duty of blessing your home.


