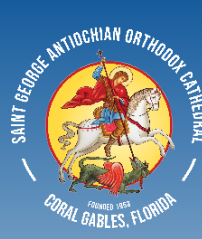

### **Kontakion of the Sunday of Last Judgment (Tone One)**

When Thou comest, O God, to earth with glory, and all creatures tremble before Thee, and the river of fire floweth before the Altar, and the books are opened and sins revealed, deliver me then from that unquenchable fire, and make me worthy to stand at Thy right hand, O righteous Judge.

### The Reading from the First Epistle of St. Paul to St. Corinthians. (8:8-9:2)

Brethren, food will not bring us closer to God; for neither if we eat, are we the better, nor if we do not eat, are we the worse. But take heed lest by any means this authority of yours become a stumbling block to those who are weak. For if any one sees you, as someone who has knowledge, reclining at a table in an idol's temple, will not the conscience of the one who is weak be emboldened to eat of the things sacrificed to idols, and through your knowledge the weak brother perishes, for whom Christ died? And thus, sinning against the brethren, and wounding their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ. Therefore, if food causes my brother to stumble, I will not eat meat forever, lest I cause my brother to stumble. Am I not an apostle? Am I not free? Have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord? Are not you my work in the Lord? If to others I am not an apostle, yet at least I am to you; for the seal of my apostleship are you in the Lord.

**The Reading from the Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew (25:31-46)**

The Lord said, "When the Son of man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. Before Him will be gathered all the nations, and He will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and He will place the sheep at His right hand, but the goats at the left. Then the King will say to those at His right hand, 'Come, O blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave Me food, I was thirsty and you gave Me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed Me, I was naked and you clothed Me, I was sick and you visited Me, I was in prison and you came to Me.' Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry and feed Thee, or thirsty and give Thee drink? And when did we see Thee a stranger and welcome Thee, or naked and clothe Thee? And when did we see Thee sick or in prison and visit Thee?' And the King will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.' Then He will say to those at his left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave Me no food, I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome Me, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.' Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when did we see Thee hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to Thee?' Then He will answer them, 'Truly, I say to you, as you did it not to one of the least of these, you did it not to Me.' And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

قَالَ الرَّبُّ: مَتَى جَاءَ ابْنُ الْبَشَرِ فِي مَجْدِهِ وَجَمِيعِ الْمَلَائِكَةِ الْقَدِيسِينَ مَعَهُ، فَحِينَئِذٍ يَجْلِسُ عَلَى عَرْشِ مَجْدِهِ. وَتُجْمَعُ إِلَيْهِ كُلُّ الْأُمَّمِ، فَيَمَيِّزُ بَعْضَهُمْ مِنْ بَعْضٍ، كَمَا يَمَيِّزُ الرَّاعِي الْخِرَافَ مِنَ الْجِدَاءِ. وَيُقِيمُ الْخِرَافَ عَنْ يَمِينِهِ وَالْجِدَاءَ عَنْ يَسَارِهِ. حِينَئِذٍ يَقُولُ الْمَلِكُ لِلَّذِينَ عَنْ يَمِينِهِ: تَعَالَوْا يَا مُبَارِكِي أَبِي رَثُوا الْمَلِكَ الْمَعْدَةَ لَكُمْ مِنْذُ إِنْشَاءِ الْعَالَمِ. لِأَنِّي جُعْتُ فَأَطَعَمْتُمُونِي، وَعَطَشْتُ فَسَقَيْتُمُونِي، وَكُنْتُ غَرِيبًا فَأَوْثَمْتُمُونِي، وَمَرِيضًا فَعَدَدْتُمُونِي، وَمَحْبُوسًا فَأَتَيْتُمُنِي إِلَى. حِينَئِذٍ يُجِيبُهُ الصَّادِقُونَ قَائِلِينَ: يَا رَبُّ مَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ جَائِعًا فَأَطَعَمْنَاكَ، أَوْ عَطَشَانًا فَسَقَيْنَاكَ؟ وَمَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ غَرِيبًا فَأَوْثَمْنَاكَ، أَوْ عَرِيضًا فَكَسَوْنَاكَ؟ وَمَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ مَرِيضًا أَوْ مَحْبُوسًا فَأَتَيْنَا إِلَيْكَ؟ فَيُجِيبُ الْمَلِكُ وَيَقُولُ لَهُمْ: الْحَقُّ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ، مَا أَنْتُمْ فَعَلْتُمْ ذَلِكَ بِأَحَدِ إِخْوَتِي هَؤُلَاءِ الصَّغَارِ فَبِي فَعَلْتُمُوهُ. حِينَئِذٍ يَقُولُ أَيْضًا لِلَّذِينَ عَنْ يَسَارِهِ: اذْهَبُوا عَنِّي يَا مَلَاعِبِينَ إِلَى النَّارِ الْأَبَدِيَّةِ الْمُعَدَّةِ لِإِبْلِيسَ وَمَلَائِكَتِهِ. لِأَنِّي جُعْتُ فَلَمْ تُطْعَمُونِي، وَعَطَشْتُ فَلَمْ تَسْقُونِي، وَكُنْتُ غَرِيبًا فَلَمْ تُؤْوِئُونِي، وَعَرِيضًا فَلَمْ تَكْسُونِي، وَمَرِيضًا وَمَحْبُوسًا فَلَمْ تَزُورُونِي. حِينَئِذٍ يُجِيبُونَهُ هُمْ أَيْضًا قَائِلِينَ: يَا رَبُّ، مَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ جَائِعًا أَوْ عَطَشَانًا أَوْ غَرِيبًا أَوْ عَرِيضًا أَوْ مَرِيضًا أَوْ مَحْبُوسًا وَلَمْ نَخْدَمْكَ؟ حِينَئِذٍ يُجِيبُهُمْ قَائِلًا: الْحَقُّ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ، مَا أَنْتُمْ لَمْ تَفْعَلُوا ذَلِكَ بِأَحَدِ هَؤُلَاءِ الصَّغَارِ، فَبِي لَمْ تَفْعَلُوهُ. فَيَذْهَبُ هَؤُلَاءِ إِلَى الْعَذَابِ الْأَبَدِيِّ، وَالصَّادِقُونَ إِلَى الْحَيَاةِ الْأَبَدِيَّةِ.

# THE SYNAXARION



On February 19 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate **The Holy Apostles of the Seventy Philemon.**

The Holy Apostles of the Seventy Philemon and his wife Apphia lived in the city of Colossa in Phrygia. After they were baptized by the holy Apostle Paul, they converted their house into a house of prayer, where all those who believed in Christ gathered and attended services. They devoted themselves to serving the sick and downcast.

Saint Philemon became bishop of the city of Gaza, and he preached the Word of God throughout Phrygia.

The holy Apostle Paul continued to be his guide, and addressed to him his Epistle filled with love, and in which he sends blessings "to Philemon our dearly beloved, and fellow laborer, and to our beloved Apphia, and to Archippus our fellow soldier, and to the church in thy house" (Phil 1:1-3).

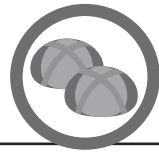
Saint Onesimus (February 15), also mentioned in the Epistle, was Saint Philemon's former slave.

Saints Philemon and Apphia, and also Saint Archippus (who also lived at Colossa), all received the crown of martyrdom during the persecution of Nero (54-68). During a pagan festival an enraged crowd rushed into the Christian church when services were going on. All fled in terror, and only Saints Philemon, Archippus and Apphia remained. They seized them and led them off to the city prefect. The crowd beat and stabbed Saint Archippus with knives, and he died on the way to the court. Saints Philemon and Apphia were stoned to death by order of the prefect.

Beloved Brother Hierarchs, reverend Clergy, and Christ-loving Faithful,

Greetings to you in the Name of our Lord, God, and Savior Jesus Christ.

This week we learned with heavy hearts of the devastation wrought by the powerful earthquake in Turkey and Syria. The toll of death and destruction is only slowly coming to light, but it is clear that thousands have died and the lives and livelihoods of many have been wrecked. In these moments, as our hearts break for our fellow man—especially for our brothers and sisters in the Faith—we feel acutely what St. Paul said about the Body of Christ: “When one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it” (1 Cor. 12:26).

Brethren, the same apostle teaches us to share what we have with those who are now in need, knowing that a time may come when they can help us. He writes, “It is not that you should be burdened so that others might have it easy. Rather, out of equality, your abundance should now go toward their need, so that their abundance might someday supply your need, so that there might be equality” (2 Cor. 8:13–14). This openhearted sharing is an affirmation of our bonds with those now suffering. It is also an expression of love, which always takes the burden of the beloved upon one’s own shoulders.

I call upon all our parishes to collect contributions each Sunday throughout the month of February for the relief of those suffering as a result of this earthquake. Immediately after each Sunday, each parish should mail a check for the funds collected that Sunday to our archdiocese headquarters and email the total amount to Mr. Daniel Nehme at our headquarters ([dnehme@antiochian.org](mailto:dnehme@antiochian.org)), which will allow us to distribute the funds more quickly. We will forward the collected funds to His Beatitude Patriarch John X as they come in, as a demonstration of our love, to be distributed through our patriarchal relief agencies to those affected by this disaster.

## **Beloved in Christ,**

This year, our journey through the Lenten fast to Pascha begins at Forgiveness Sunday, February 26. The Church, in her wisdom, begins preparing us for this most-holy time in the weeks that precede the fast. This email provides encouragement for you regarding the fasting guidelines for the pre-Lenten period of preparation, Great Lent, and Holy Week, according to the general practice in our Diocese.

The word “fast” means not eating all or certain foods. Simultaneously, we should be fasting from sin while praying more and living more fully the Orthodox life. Fast is a personal, spiritual discipline. We aren't to compare our fasting with anyone else. Neither should we be prideful about our fasting nor judge those who don't fully participate in this spiritual journey.

Saint John Chrysostom teaches that it is more important to fast from sin. For example, besides controlling what goes into our mouths, we must control what comes out of our mouths as well. He notes that other members of the body also need to fast: (1) our eyes from seeing evil, (2) our ears from hearing evil and (3) our bodies from participating in anything that is not of God. Most important of all, we need to control our thoughts, for thoughts are the sources of our actions, whether good or evil.

Fasting isn't forced upon us. In the same way that true repentance can never be forced upon anyone, each of us makes the choice to turn away from our sinful ways and go toward our loving, forgiving Father in heaven.

We shouldn't give up if we fail in some aspect of our fasting. Remember, we are beginners in one way or another on this spiritual journey of becoming like Christ. If we fail, no matter in a small or big way, we should resume fasting and other spiritual activities. Remember, the evil demons want us to give up! It is important to note that fasting is a spiritual discipline that should be practiced with the oversight and direction of your spiritual father.

## **Why do we fast?**

- ***To become like Jesus Who also fasted,***
- ***To be assisted in our repentance and our movement towards God, (St. Basil the Great),***
- ***To speak a little less, so as to hear the whisper of God's voice more,***
- ***To cleanse our lives from sin,***
- ***To grow closer to the Lord,***
- ***To gain control of our appetites of the flesh and let God transform our lives, and most importantly,***
- ***To deepen our relationship with Christ, which will result having more love toward God and our neighbor.***

## **WEEKS OF PREPARATION 2023 (February 5 – 26)**

Four Sundays of preparation precede Great Lent. The Church eases us into the fasting discipline during these weeks of preparation as follows:

- February 5 was the Sunday of the **Publican and Pharisee** and the week that follows (February 6 – 12) is fast-free. There is no Wednesday or Friday fast this week.

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- February 12 is the Sunday of the **Prodigal Son** and the week that follows (February 13 – 19) is a normal week with Wednesday and Friday as fasting days.
- February 19 is **Meatfare Sunday** (the Sunday of the Last Judgment) and on this day we say “farewell” to meat. During the week that follows (February 20 – 26) we fast from meat only. All dairy, cheese, eggs, wine, and oil are permitted during this week, even on Wednesday and Friday.
- February 26 is **Cheesefare Sunday** (the Sunday of Forgiveness) and on this day we say “farewell” to cheese, dairy, eggs, wine and olive oil while continuing to abstain from meat and fish.

## GREAT LENT AND HOLY WEEK 2023 (February 27 – April 15)

The Lenten fasting discipline commences after Forgiveness Vespers on March 6 and concludes with the breaking of the fast at Pascha on April 16. In general, the fasting rules during Great Lent and Holy Week are as follows:

**WEEKDAYS** (Monday – Friday) are observed as *Strict Fast Days*. On these days we abstain from meat, dairy, fish with backbones, fowl, wine and oil.

**WEEKENDS** (Saturday and Sunday) are observed as *Wine and Oil Days*. On these days the fast is relaxed to permit wine and olive oil.

In addition, two special feasts that fall during this period – **Annunciation (March 25)** and **Palm Sunday (April 9, this year)** – are kept as *Fish, Wine, and Oil Days*. On these days the fast is relaxed to permit fish with backbones, in addition to wine and olive oil.

There are certain days of the Holy Week cycle that have special fasting rules.

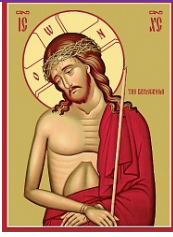
- **Great and Holy Thursday (April 13, this year)** is observed as a *Wine and Oil Day* due to the commemoration of the institution of the Eucharist.
- **Great and Holy Saturday (April 15, this year)** is observed as a *Strict Fast Day* – the only Saturday of the year kept as a strict fast; however, wine (but not oil) is permitted.

Additional Notes:

1. Meals portions should be smaller than usual.
2. Fasting on the weekdays of the first week of Great Lent is especially severe. The strictest observance would be to take only 2 meals during this week – 1 on Wednesday evening and 1 on Friday evening after the services scheduled for those nights – keeping Clean Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday as absolute fasts (i.e., no food whatsoever). ***For many this is impracticable.*** A good starting place to work towards the strict observance is to keep the first day of Great Lent, Clean Monday, as an absolute fast and to limit meals on the other days.
3. It is a pious practice to observe Great and Holy Friday as an absolute fast. If one does not have the strength to do this, it is good to abstain from food until after venerating the epitaphios (winding sheet) during Vespers on this day.
4. If you have a medical condition that requires you to relax the fasting guidelines, then do so.
5. Generally speaking, beginners plus children and elderly people are allowed to relax the fast under the guidance of their spiritual father.

**Please consult me before you attempt to strictly follow the fasting guidelines.** Fasting is an ideal for which we should strive, but it is not end in itself. Becoming like Jesus is our ultimate goal.

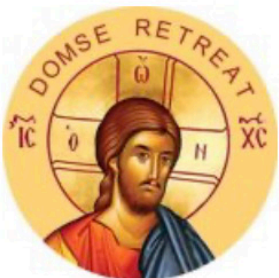

## Home Blessing Scheduling Form

On January 6th, we celebrated the services for the Great Feast of Theophany (عيد الغطاس), in which we commemorate the Baptism of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We also prayed the service of the "Great Sanctification of Water", which marks the beginning of the home blessing season. Traditionally, the blessed waters are used to sanctify the homes of all the faithful. In bringing the blessed water to the homes, and sprinkling it in each room, we rid our home of any evil influence, and re-dedicate it to God in a special way. As we were once renewed by the waters of our own baptism into Christ, so too our home, and our entire lives, are re-dedicated and renewed unto Christ our God each year at this time.

1. The home blessing form **MUST** be filled out and submitted either online or using this form. Please return to Fr. Paul or the Church office.
2. A follow-up call will take place from the Church Office to confirm the appointment day and time.
3. Fr. Paul will contact you before arriving to your home (at least 15 minutes prior to arrival). He will call you once more when he is in front of the house.

**The official Clergy Manual of the Antiochian Archdiocese of North America states: The pastor MUST SEE that the home of EACH PARISHIONER is visited and blessed each year during the days following Epiphany or other Major Feast Days where the weather conditions are permissible. Therefore, please, let nothing stand in between the priest and the fulfillment of his priestly duty of blessing your home.**

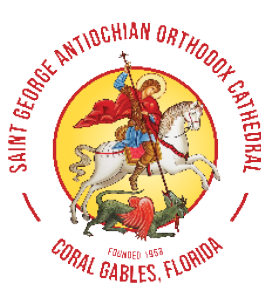
