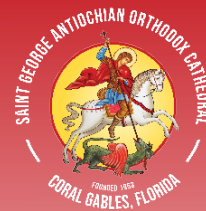

Entrance Hymn of Pascha

In the gathering places bless God the Lord, from the springs of Israel. Save us, O Son of God, Who art risen from the dead, who sing to Thee: Alleluia.

Apolytikion of the Resurrection (Tone Three)

Let the heavens rejoice and the earth be glad, for the Lord hath done a mighty act with His own arm. He hath trampled down death by death, and become the first-born from the dead. He hath delivered us from the depths of Hades, granting the world the Great Mercy.

The Reading from the Acts of the Apostles (9:32-42).

In those days, as Peter went throughout all regions, he came down also to the saints who dwelt at Lydda. There he found a certain man named Aeneas, who was bedridden for eight years and paralyzed. And Peter said to him: "Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you; arise and make your bed." And immediately he arose. And all who dwelt at Lydda and Sharon saw him, and they turned back to the Lord. Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha (which means Gazelle). She was full of good works and of charitable deeds which she did. And it came to pass in those days that she fell sick and died; and when they had washed her, they placed her in an upper chamber. Since Lydda was near Joppa, the disciples, hearing that Peter was there, sent two men to him entreating him: "Come to us without delay!" So Peter arose and went with them. And when he arrived, they took him into the upper chamber. All the widows stood by him weeping, showing the tunics and other garments which Tabitha made while she was with them. But Peter put them all outside and knelt down and prayed; then turning to the body, he said: "Tabitha, arise!" And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter, she sat up. And he gave her his hand, and raised her up. Then he called the saints and widows and presented her alive. And it became known throughout all Joppa, and many believed in the Lord.

فِي تِلْكَ الْأَيَّامِ، فِيمَا كَانَ بُطْرُسُ يَطُوفُ فِي جَمِيعِ الْأَمَاكِنِ، نَزَلَ أَيْضاً إِلَى الْقَدِيسِينَ السَّاكِنِينَ فِي لُدَّة. فَوَجَدَ هُنَاكَ إِنْسَانًا اسْمُهُ أَيْنِيَّاسُ، مُضْطَجِعًا عَلَى سَرِيرٍ مِنْذُ ثَمَانِي سِنِينَ، وَهُوَ مُخْلَعٌ. فَقَالَ لَهُ بُطْرُسُ: "يَا أَيْنِيَّاسُ، يَشْفِيكَ يَسُوعُ الْمَسِيحُ؛ فُمْ وَافْتَرِشْ لِنَفْسِكَ." فَقَامَ لِلْوَقْتِ. وَرَأَهُ جَمِيعُ السَّاكِنِينَ فِي لُدَّة وَسَارُونَ فَرَجَعُوا إِلَى الرَّبِّ. وَكَانَتْ فِي يَافَا تَلْمِيذَةٌ اسْمُهَا طَابِيثَا، الَّتِي تَفْسِيرُهُ ظَبْيَةٌ، وَكَانَتْ هَذِهِ مُمْتَلِئَةً أَعْمَالًا صَالِحَةً وَصَدَقَاتٍ كَانَتْ تَعْمَلُهَا. فَحَدَّثَتْ فِي تِلْكَ الْأَيَّامِ أَنَّهَا مَرِضَتْ وَمَاتَتْ. فَغَسَلُوهَا وَوَضَعُوهَا فِي الْعَلِيَّةِ. وَإِذْ كَانَتْ لُدَّةُ بِقُرْبِ يَافَا، وَسَمِعَ التَّلَامِيذُ أَنَّ بُطْرُسَ فِيهَا، أَرْسَلُوا إِلَيْهِ رَجُلَيْنِ يَسْأَلَانِهِ أَنْ لَا يُبْطِئَ عَنِ الْقُدُومِ إِلَيْهِمْ. فَقَامَ بُطْرُسُ وَأَتَى مَعَهُمَا. فَلَمَّا وَصَلَ، صَعِدُوا بِهِ إِلَى الْعَلِيَّةِ، وَوَقَّفَ لَدَيْهِ جَمِيعَ الْأَرَامِلِ يَبْكِينَ، وَيُرِينَهُ أَقْمَصَةً وَثِيَابًا كَانَتْ تَصْنَعُهَا ظَبْيَةً مَعَهُنَّ. فَأَخْرَجَ بُطْرُسُ الْجَمِيعَ خَارِجًا، وَجَثَا عَلَى رُكْبَتَيْهِ وَصَلَّى. ثُمَّ التَفَّتْ إِلَى الْجَسَدِ وَقَالَ: "يَا طَابِيثَا قُومِي." فَفَتَحَتْ عَيْنَيْهَا. وَمَلَّمَا أَبْصَرَتْ بُطْرُسَ جَلَسَتْ. فَتَنَاوَلَهَا يَدَهُ وَأَنْهَضَهَا. ثُمَّ دَعَا الْقَدِيسِينَ وَالْأَرَامِلَ، وَأَقَامَهَا لَدَيْهِمْ حَيَّةً. فَشَاعَ هَذَا الْخَبْرُ فِي يَافَا كُلِّهَا، فَآمَنَ كَثِيرُونَ بِالرَّبِّ.

The Reading of the Holy Gospel according to St. John (5:1-15).

At that time, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, in Hebrew called Bethesda, which has five porticoes. In these lay a multitude of invalids, blind, lame, paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water. For an angel of the Lord went down at certain seasons into the pool and troubled the water; whoever stepped in first, after the troubling of the water was healed of whatever disease he had. One man was there, who had been ill for 38 years. When Jesus saw him and knew that he had been lying there a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be healed?" The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is troubled, and while I am going another steps down before me." Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your pallet, and walk." And at once the man was healed, and he took up his pallet and walked. Now that day was the Sabbath. So the Jews said to the man who was cured, "It is the Sabbath, it is not lawful for you to carry your pallet." But he answered them, "The man who healed me said to me, 'Take up your pallet, and walk.'" They asked him, "Who is the man who said to you, 'Take up your pallet, and walk'?" Now the man who had been healed did not know who it was, for Jesus had withdrawn, as there was a crowd in the place. Afterward, Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, you are well! Sin no more, that nothing worse befalls you." The man went away and told the Jews that it was Jesus Who had healed him.

فصل شريف من بشارة القديس يوحنا الإنجيلي البشير والتلميذ الطاهر.

في ذلك الزمان، صعد يسوع إلى أورشليم. وإن في أورشليم عند باب الغنم بركة، تسمى بالعبرانية بيت حسد، لها خمسة أزوقة. كان مضطجعا فيها جمهور كثير من المرضى من عميان وعرج ويابسي الأعضاء، ينتظرون تحريك الماء. لأن ملاكا كان ينزل أحيانا في البركة ويحرك الماء. والذي كان ينزل أولا من بعد تحريك الماء، كان يبرا من أي مرض اعتراه. وكان هناك إنسان به مرض منذ ثمان وثلاثين سنة. هذا إذ رآه يسوع ملقى، وعلم أن له زمانا كثيرا، قال له: "أتريد أن تبرا؟" فأجابته المريض: "يا سيدي، ليس لي إنسان متى حرك الماء يلقيني في البركة، بل بينما أكون آتيا، ينزل قبلي آخر." فقال له يسوع: "قم، احمل سريرك وامش." فللوقت برئ الرجل، وحمّل سيره ومشى. وكان في ذلك اليوم سبت. فقال اليهودي للذي شفي: "إنه سبت، فلا يجز لك أن تحمل السرير." فأجابهم: "إن الذي أبراني هو قال لي 'احمل سريرك وامش.'" فسأله من هو الإنسان الذي قال لك "احمل سريرك وامش؟" أما الذي شفي فلم يكن يعلم من هو. لأن يسوع اعترل، إذ كان في الموضع جمع. وبعد ذلك وجدته يسوع في الهيكل، فقال له: "ها قد عوفيت، فلا تعد تخطئ لئلا يصيبك شر." فذهب ذلك الإنسان، وأخبر اليهود أن يسوع هو الذي أبراه.



THE SYNAXARION

On May 7 in the Holy Orthodox Church, we commemorate **the Precious Cross that appeared in the sky over Jerusalem in 351 A.D.**

St. Cyril of Jerusalem was born in or near the Holy City in the year 315. There are no records of his early life, but we know of his ordination to the priesthood in the year 346. He was given responsibility for preaching to the faithful in Jerusalem and preparing catechumens for Baptism. Only four years later, Cyril became Patriarch of Jerusalem on the death of Patriarch Maximus. A miracle occurred in Jerusalem during this time about which we have well-documented testimony. St. Cyril wrote to the Emperor about it and there were many eye-witnesses.

On May 7, at about 9:00 in the morning, the form of a cross appeared in the sky over Jerusalem. It was positioned over Golgotha and reached to the Mount of Olives. This vision lasted for several hours and appeared to be brighter than the sun. Those who witnessed this phenomenon ran to the Church in Jerusalem, praising Jesus Christ as Lord of all.

In a manner which is usually associated with political rivals, Acacius, Archbishop of Caesarea, (who eventually became an outspoken Arian) began complaints against Cyril to his friend the Emperor Constantius. His jurisdiction over Jerusalem, his theology, and even his use of the funds of the Jerusalem church were used by Acacius to discredit him. Patriarch Cyril was exiled from Jerusalem and was given hospitality by Sylvanus, the Bishop of Tarsus. Here he spent his time in writing. Sylvanus later became a "Semi-Arian", and St. Cyril's reputation is sometimes clouded by his time spent with him, although Cyril never wavered from Orthodox belief.

Julian the "Apostate" became Emperor next and, contrary to what any would have thought, he recalled bishops who had been exiled by his predecessor, so Cyril returned to Jerusalem. Perhaps Julian intended to stir up more trouble among Christians as the Arian heresy was spreading rapidly.

Julian also proposed a project which was rife with controversy. He suggested to the Jewish population that they rebuild the temple in Jerusalem. Christian leaders such as Patriarch Cyril reminded the public that Christ had predicted the fall of the Temple and that his sacrifice had replaced all the animal sacrifices which the Jews had made in the Temple. When the Jews began the work of rebuilding, several earthquakes destroyed the work that had been done and put an end to the project. We have accounts of this event, which occurred in 363, written by St. Gregory Nazianzen and St. John Chrysostom, among others.

Patriarch Cyril endured another exile under the Arian Emperor Valens, beginning in 367, but was restored on the accession of Gratian in 378. The Patriarch attended the Second Ecumenical Council in Constantinople in 381, where he participated in the formulation of the Nicene Creed. In the year 386, at the age of 71, St. Cyril fell asleep in the Lord. He had been faithful to Orthodox Christian teaching through the turmoil of false accusations and exile due to an unholy mixture of politics and religion.



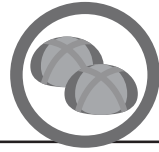

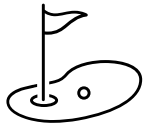
