### WHERE IS CHRIST?

As we prepare ourselves to receive Christ, born for our salvation, we often find ourselves contemplating, "Where is Christ?" We look for Him in the magnificent liturgies and the rich theology. We seek His presence in

the Church's holy services, rituals, and within the sacred pages of the Scriptures.

Yet, in our hearts, we must ask, "Where is Christ, truly?"

The late Patriarch of Antioch, Ignatius IV, writes that Christ is often found where we least expect. He is not necessarily in our glamour or worldly glorification, nor is He confined to what society considers greatness. Christ transcends mere rituals, rules, and human wisdom.

Instead, Christ manifests in simple and humble hearts. The face of Christ is reflected in the eyes of the poor, the sick, and the marginalized—those often overlooked or ignored by our society. He is present in the weary traveler, the struggling neighbor, and the silent sufferer.

***Every day, in every face we encounter, we have an opportunity to meet Christ.***
