loves the world He created, He wants to keep it forever. When God made humans and everything else, He said it was good. Even when people mess things up, God does everything He can to make things right again. God loves the world so much that He sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to die so that everyone and everything could be saved. Christ came, He died, He defeated death, and He sent the Holy Spirit of Love into the world, into the hearts of those who want to live and love like Him.

Our job as Christians is to love others and everything, even our enemies, just like Jesus loved us. He said, "Love one another as I have loved you" (John 12:34). Our goal is to be perfect like God is perfect, to be the perfect example of love, just as God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit – is the perfect union of love that never changes.

Since everything is based on love because God is love, we need to show our love actively. Love is all about serving and making sacrifices for others. That's how God shows His love for us, by serving and sacrificing Himself, even to the point of Jesus

being crucified on the cross. He gave His life on the cross because He said, "There's no greater love than giving your life for someone else" (John 15:34).

So, Christ tells us to follow His example and love like He did, not just our friends but also our enemies. When we do that, we're imitating God and actively helping to save the world. Salvation means making everything – God, angels, people, animals, plants, and even the whole universe – perfect by living in loving unity with Divine Love.

This is what Christianity is all about – love. It's the foundation of our philosophy of life. "Everything is love because God is Love."

Like St. Paul said, "Love is patient and kind; it's not jealous or boastful; it doesn't act proud or rude. Love doesn't insist on its own way; it's not easily upset or resentful. It doesn't like wrongdoing but rejoices in what's right. Love can handle anything, trust anything, hope for anything, and endure anything. Love never ends" (1 Corinthians 13).

Dear beloved parishioners,

Christ is born. Glorify Him.

This letter serves as an official call for the 2023 Annual General Assembly Meeting of Saint George Antiochian Orthodox Cathedral. The Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 21, 2024, and will take place in the Cathedral Hall immediately following the Divine Liturgy. An agenda for the meeting is attached for your reference.

According to our Constitution, only voting members may participate in voting on agenda items, such as electing new members of the Parish Council or addressing other official business. However, it is important to note that this meeting is open to all members of the Cathedral, not just the voting members. Our Cathedral recognizes two types of membership: voting membership and general non-voting membership. We strongly encourage all church members, both voting and non-voting, to attend the General Assembly Meeting. This is a valuable opportunity to learn about the Cathedral's operations, ministries, and vision. Everyone's presence and input are crucial, as each member plays a vital role in defining our future and contributing to the growth of the Cathedral and the fulfillment of our mission.

A voting member is defined as a "member in good standing" who fulfills all the following criteria:

1. An individual who is baptized or received into the Orthodox Church.

This year, there will be a Parish Council election for four members for a three-year term. The Nominating Committee, consisting of Mrs. Lama El Haj, Mrs. Andrea M. Abu-Akel, and Sdn. Elie Bardawil, will prepare a list of candidates and submit it to the Dean of the Cathedral by January 12, 2024. All parishioners in good standing who are interested in serving on the Parish Council and willing to make the commitment required to fulfill this important responsibility must discuss with the Dean before submitting their name and then submit their candidacy to the Nominating Committee, using the provided form, by January 11, 2024, to be included on the ballot. No nominations will be accepted after this deadline or from the floor during the meeting.

Please be advised that the upcoming assembly will include a presentation of the financial report for 2023, the proposed 2024 Annual Budget, and reports from various church organizations.

Your active involvement in the Annual General Assembly Meeting is crucial for guiding our Cathedral and shaping its future. Through our shared vision, commitment, and the grace of God, we will chart our path forward.


